

## **Wiki Assignment 2 – 40 points – Due Tuesday October 25<sup>th</sup>**

This assignment will require you to create a minimum of 4 pages on your current wiki.

- To create a new page, click “New Page.”
- Pages should be named: **Convergent Boundaries, Divergent Boundaries, Transform Boundaries, and Review.**
- Each page must contain at least one original graphic that is relevant to that page. Some examples are: animations, audio clips, voki, photoshop graphic, cool text, video, original artwork (can be scanned in), photos, or any other item YOU have created.
- One page must contain a video or link to a video relevant to that page’s information.

- labeled photo showing evidence of this boundary some place on Earth.

#### **Section 4**

- definition/description of Ocean vs. Ocean (must include subduction, trench, island arc)
- graphic showing O vs. O convergence
- labeled photo showing evidence of this boundary some place on Earth.

### **Page 2 – Divergent Boundaries – (must have AT LEAST 2 links for resources used)**

#### **Section 1**

- definition/description of divergent boundaries

#### **Section 2**

- definition/des. of Ocean vs. Ocean (include sea-floor spreading & mid-ocean ridge)
- graphic showing O vs. O divergence
- labeled photo showing evidence of this boundary some place on Earth.

## **Page 3 – Transform Boundaries – (must have AT LEAST 2 links for resources used)**

- definition/description of transform boundaries (including fault)
- graphic showing transform boundary
- labeled photo showing evidence of this boundary some place on Earth.

## **Page 4 – Review**

For this page, you must create a product to help review for a test on the previous 3 items.

Some examples could be:

- a video which asks questions and provides answers
- a powerpoint quiz
- a typed quiz with answer sheet
- a crossword puzzle with clues (can be created by you or at [www.puzzlemaker.com](http://www.puzzlemaker.com))
- a survey with questions (<http://app.zoomerang.com/Home/>) answers or link to answers should be provided on your page.
- any other creative way to review material presented.
